



## WRITING TASK: Idolspace

### Writing someone's biography

You are going to make a personal profile of someone famous either in Indonesia or in the world.

1. Copy the activity sheet in your exercise book.
2. Bring in a photograph or a picture of a famous person or your idol for the next class.
3. Think about a motto that the person has in his/her life.
4. Think about what personal information (name, birthday, hometown, etc.) you want to include in his/her profile.
5. Think about things that the person likes.
6. Now complete all sections in the *Idolspace* profile sheet.
7. When these sections are completed, work in groups of six or seven and pass the profiles around the group.
8. Read your classmates' profiles. If you want to write a comment or a question, do this on the 'message board'. If you want to draw a picture or make a statement, do this on the 'graffiti wall.'
9. When the *Idolspace* profiles are complete, give your profile to your teacher to comment on.
10. Copy your work again, paying attention to your teacher's comments and suggestions.
11. Put both copies in your portfolio with your completed self-assessment form.
