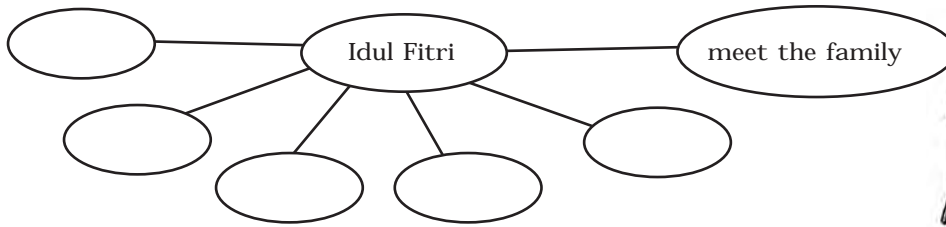




10 Joyful Idul Fitri in India

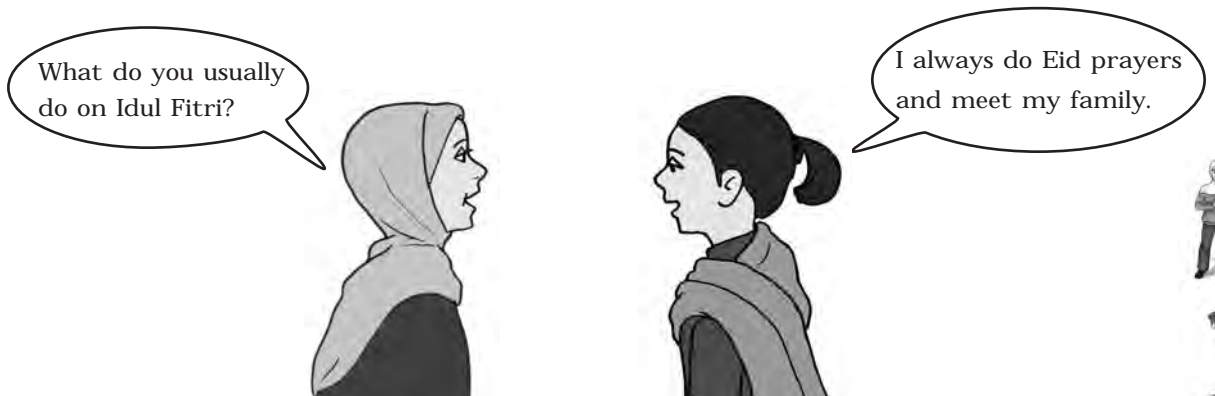
